



Clarification of the Rights, Benefits & Restrictions Of Affiliates of the ABS

Affiliates will be listed as such in the ABS Annual Report and other publications e.g 'Pillars of the Economy' and are invited to supply information for the 'Year in Focus' section. They will receive copies of all such publications.

Associates will be invited to send representatives to:

- ABS Events, Conferences and workshops etc.
- ABS Training & Development programmes

(at the same fee levels as full members)

Affiliates can:

- Contribute information for inclusion in the ABS Conference Calendar and in the press section of the ABS website.
- Have a hot link from the ABS website to their own website

An institution granted 'Affiliate' status is not a member of ABS and should not claim to be in any of its publications. The agreed wording is '...(name of institution) ...is an Affiliate of the Association of Business Schools.' On this basis, Affiliates are not allowed to use the ABS logo on any publication.

Affiliates do not have voting rights, nor can their representatives seek membership of the ABS Executive or any sub-committees.
